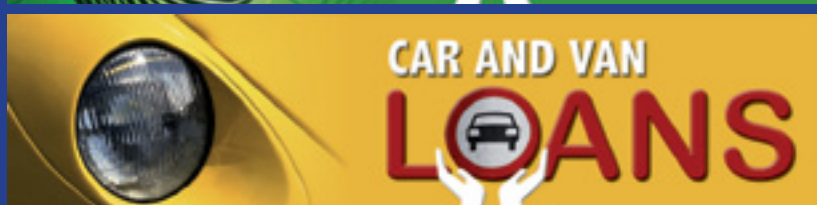

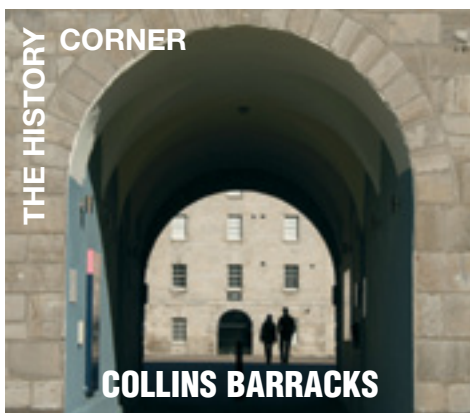

## THE HISTORY CORNER



## COLLINS BARRACKS

ORIGINALLY THE ROYAL BARRACKS it was built in the in the early 1700s. Covering 18 acres, it was the first permanent barracks outside of Britain and was the oldest occupied barracks in the world until the Irish Army moved out in 1997. It was built by Thomas Burgh (also Dr Stevens Hospital and Library TCD) to house 1,500 men and 500 horses. However, at one time it billeted 5,000 soldiers.

It was an important location in the suppression of the 1798 rebellion and, indeed, Wolfe Tone died in the barracks. About 200 "croppies" who were ultimately disposed of in the Croppy Acre, were interned and executed here.

For the next century things were very quiet but the barracks added hugely to the industry of the area particularly on Barrack Street (Benburb Street) which housed bakers, butchers, creameries, musket makers, tailors, shoemakers and of course ladies of the night!

The Royal Barracks was handed over to the Free State Army in December 1922 and was renamed Collins Barracks. It remained an Irish Army Barracks up to 1997. It is now the History and Decorative Arts branch of the National Museum of Ireland. It is well worth a visit even just to see the buildings and the military squares. Go on, it's free!
